

**Report of the Proceedings of Annual General Body Meeting of NOSA

Resolutions passed in the AGB, 2007

Thereafter, the participants have proceeded for Photo Session in the assembly ground. Photos were taken in both whole group and batch wise, with the help of Mr. Jaison, Art Teacher, JNV.
